

## Acts to be performed for obtaining a plenary Indulgence for poor souls of purgatory

- From November 1 to 8: visit of a cemetery with mental prayer for the poor souls.
- On November 2: visit of a church or an oratory with one Our Father and one Creed being recited.

#### **Chaplet for the Deceased**

**Beads** ~ This chaplet consists of a crucifix, followed by five introductory beads, and four groups of 10 beads, each separated by one bead. The 40 beads are in memory of the 40 hours that Our Lord is thought to have spent when He descended to the dead, to preach the Gospel, and to deliver the souls of the just who had died before Him.

Color ~ Black and other

Patronage ~ The Holy Souls in Purgatory

#### On the large beads:

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord.

And let perpetual light shine upon them.

May they rest in peace.

Amen.

May their souls, and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.

Amen.

#### On the small beads:

Sweet Heart of Mary, be my salvation!

At the end of the four decades, pray:

O God, the Creator and Redeemer of all the faithful, grant to the souls of your departed servants the remission of all their sins, that through pious supplications they may obtain the pardon which they have always desired. In Jesus' name. Amen.

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord.

And let perpetual light shine upon them.

May they rest in peace.

Amen.

May their souls, and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.
